

Looking for rural family medicine maternity leave locum starting May 24 and hoping for 6 months but I am flexible

Location: Bracebridge, ON (Muskoka). 2h north of Toronto FHT practice with ~1200 patients - I usually do 5-6 half days a week in outpatient clinic. You could assort these half days however you like and make your own schedule. After hours clinic is one Tuesday a month, and 1/12 Friday evenings.

I am MRP for my own patients when they are admitted to hospital - usually there are around 2. I don't have to go in every day. Nursing staff is excellent and call as appropriate. Weekend call coverage is 1 in 9 and split between other physicians in the FHT

My patient panel is very lovely, polite, respectful, well trained and grateful for care. Caring for them is truly the greatest joy and privileges of the work I do.

Lots of opportunity within the community to do other clinical activities if you want - e.g. hospitalist, ER, FM-OB, or palliative work at South Muskoka Memorial Hospital, adjacent to clinic.

PS Suite EMR in clinic with combo Citrix/paper based charts in hospital \$500 for each half day clinic with 100% third party billings + \$500 per week to cover administrative time for paperwork & inbox management

I usually have a nurse Tuesday mornings to do injections for my patients. If you would like more nursing staff I could help arrange this. My clinic support staff includes my own MoA who knows my patients very well. I have supportive physician colleagues within the office and our community although rural it is well supported by specialists — Internal Medicine, Cardiology, Urology, General Surgery, FP Anesthesia, FP Obstetrics. Excellent collegial atmosphere within and outside of the hospital.
